Maintenance Terms and Conditions

- All accounts must be paid in full prior to or on the due date before 5:00 PM.
- Unless prior arrangements are made, all past due accounts will incur a \$ 25 or 12% charge (whichever is greater)
- Customer agrees to pay MAA attorney fees in connection with any collection of amount due.
- Customer agrees to pre-pay for parts by providing a check, credit card, or cash deposit. All past due accounts (including late fees and interest) will be charged to the card on file.
- In order to receive log entries all customers are required to provide maintenance logs.
- After hours labor rates are \$112.50 per hour. Weekends/ Holidays / Emergencies are \$150.00 per hour (minimum of two hours)
- For aircraft requiring defueling. Fuel cannot be stored for reuse and will be disposed of accordingly
- All parts not purchased through MAA must be accompanied by a release tag (no exceptions)
- Service request days are not guaranteed. All maintenance must be scheduled at least two weeks ahead of time. Maintenance not scheduled accordingly will be performed as time permits.
- Customer grants security interest with all the rights and remedies as provided by State and Federal law, in collateral described or referred to above in order to secure the payment of all sums now due or which may become due for all repair work done.
- MAA guarantees all repairs and installations to be defect free for a period of 90 days from the aircraft being returned to service.
- Manufacturer's extended warranties are the responsibility of the customer. Any outstanding payments deriving from such warranties owed to MAA are the customer's responsibility.
- Customer agrees that M.A.A is not responsible for my aircraft or any items in case of fire, theft, accidents, or other causes.
- Customer agrees that MAA is not responsible for any damage to his/her aircraft resulting from our maintenance, repairs, or inspections.
- Customer authorizes Mid Atlantic Aviation to perform the work described in this form including the installation of necessary parts and materials.
- Customer agrees that his/her insurance is always considered primary for any loss of any nature. MAA will not be held responsible for any damage caused by any aircraft operation conducted by MAA.
- Customer agrees to provide payment upon completion of work or arrange satisfactory payment terms with MAA.
- By signing the Maintenance Authorization Form customer agrees to all terms and conditions set by Mid Atlantic Aviation.
